## **The Russian, Lipetsk, Club Station RT5G**

Our club station recently bought a piece of land about 15Km from Lipetsk and have started to build their contest position. The station current members are;

Victor R3GZ, Larry R5GA, Vlad RO3G, Yuri R5GM, Andy R3GG,

Dick R3GM, Victor RG5G, Gary UG3G, Anatoly RW3GB,

Gennady UA3GIE.

For two years we have been constructing antenna masts. During that time there has been lots of snow but with some sunny good days, the temperature in the winter has been around minus 28C. We also experienced very high winds, which together with the snow and ice caused damage to the antenna system. The general construction of the antenna masts can be seen in the pictures. Note the damage referred to above, the repairs were made during the very cold weather !

### **The antenna installed currently are;**

160 metre vertical 52m height used also as a 5/8 lambda on 80 m with tuner. Also on 80m we have a Sloper (to East), height is 55m, Inverted Vee with feed point at 25 metres.

For 40m we use a Full size three element Yargi Beam, 25 metres high and a two element wire Yargi beaming East/West also at 25m high. Another 40m antenna is a Delta with switching over at a height of 65 metres.

For 20/15/10 metres an Open Sleeve (at a height 65 metres and a Dipoles made with pipes). Also a rotary 6 element for 20m, a 3 element for 15m, and a 5 element for 10m at a height of 15 metres.

8 el. for 15m, with an 8 el. for 10m, at a height of 25 metres...

And a lot of Beverage antennas for receiving (250-350 meters long)

These antennas have been built during the two years since we bough the land. We have plans for more development of our antennas for 2011...


